Each water feature is approximately 33 ft. long and 12 ft. wide and are positioned perpendicular to each other on each side of a main entry. From the top of each reflecting pool, water falls down textured basalt and falls into an overflowing granite pool that rises one foot above the dry river rock bed. A large concrete reservoir tank was used along with equipment in a concrete vault to clean and circulate the water.
