Handmade from copper with a bronze patina, the water flows over dark grey basalt tiles. It consists of three stepped segments that culminate in a 4-foot diameter pool, lit with colorful lights for a vibrant atmosphere. This water feature creates a serene and calming environment, offering a respite from the bustling daily life of a busy law firm.
