



Tower Road Sculpture with Rivulets

A two-level copper feature adds the sound and movement of water to an outdoor patio of a modern Beverly Hills home. Cascading water forms textured waves that move down the taller ridged copper tier. A second curved sculptural form creates a complementary curtain of rivulets falling into a bed of river rocks.
